Mike Kelly reports about possibility of putting in temporary speed bump on Croatan Road to limit speed to 25mph or below, minor cost associated, signage to indicate bump ahead, possible detriment is noise
Motion to explore this with neighborhood by Bob Loughen, seconded by Katie R, motion approved
- 13.0 8.15 New Business (Croatan Parking Permit / Party Pass)
Ken Jobe reports about meeting with Director of Public Works, with Phil Davenport about Temporary Parking Pass Program- Surfriider Foundation has complained that Croatan residents get favorable treatment because they have the option to apply for and use “the pass”
Discussion about south of Maryland- currently some neighbors just “bag” the no parking signs and park there. As far as parking is concerned there are difficulties parking near any home in a “red zone” City suggests residents could have on-street parking 9:30 am-7 pm, which opens possibility of after-hours temporary passes
Discussion about Virginia Dare Drive-grassy patch would be converted to parking “lot” or parking spots Croatan Rd to Vanderbilt Temporary Parking pass.
Residents of South Maryland do not want on street parking, it will remain a “red zone”
Residents reject Parking lot on Virginia Dare/point at Vanderbilt
Where is the bike path on Virginia Dare? This is not a viable excuse for a reason not to have parking.
