# VBCCO Meeting Wednesday. January 15, 2025

- Brandon Kyle, Operations Police Services Manager, cancelled for this meeting and rescheduled for the March meeting.
- There was an open discussion about VBCCO University. The City is interested in creating some sort of educational program for Citizens. VBCCO met with Nancy Bloom, City of Virginia Beach Community Engagement Manager. The City and VBCCO might work together to create educational content for citizens utilizing VBCCO University.
- The City is on the 3rd wave of the Comprehensive Development Plan(Comp Plan). They want to get more community engagement this time.
- VBCCO is pursuing \$1000 per Civic League member to promote civic involvement. In theory, CCL we pay \$50 in dues and would in turn get \$1000 to spend as the Board sees fit. Time will tell if VBCCO will get Council members to sign off on it.
- VBCCO 2025 dues will be due when we receive an email bill.

- VB Cultural Affairs website has grant opportunities for artistic projects like building community library boxes like we have on Vanderbilt Ave. in Croatan.
- The current City Council is in favor of maintaining Single Family Zoning in existing communities. VBCCO is considering drafting a resolution stating that and have the Council members all sign it.

# Safety/Security - February, 2025

Bottom Line Up Front:

- Clear the Sensor
- Black Ice
- Stay Off of Ice
- Citizen's Advisory Committee (CAC) Next meeting February 12; Situational Awareness

<u>Clear the Sensor</u>: I am not sure how many more frosty mornings we'll have this winter, but I was recently reminded (by my car) to scrape the windshield in front of the sensors. Many new vehicles have optical and radio frequency (R/F) sensors that help drivers with adaptive speed control, automatic braking, lane keeping, etc. If sensors are not free of frost, they will not work properly. If you have to scrape the windshield, please ensure that you clear the area in front of the sensors. It might be worth investing in a long-handled scraper/brush as vehicles grow increasingly larger.

<u>Black Ice</u>: We can't say it enough – if the temperature is near of below 32 degrees and the road appears wet, consider the presence of black ice and adjust your driving accordingly. This includes roadways in morning shadows and elevated highways, bridges, and overpasses.

<u>Ice Safety</u>: We were saddened to hear of the recent drowning death of a 12-year-old boy who apparently fell through ice on a pond. Although we've had some temperatures below freezing, Virginia Beach rarely gets cold enough for ice to thicken/strengthen sufficiently to support an individual. Even if you can swim, the shock of the frigid water immersion could incapacitate you.

<u>Citizen's Advisory Committee (CAC)</u>: The next CAC meeting will be held on February 12, 2025 at 7:00 PM in the conference room of Virginia Beach Volunteer Rescue Squad #14, 740 VB Blvd (17<sup>th</sup> Street). Please park on the east side of the building. CAC meetings are open to all.

Safety is Everyone's Responsibility: At the January CAC meeting, VBPD Lieutenant Jennifer van Note responded to citizen concerns about the risk of copycat mass-casualty incidents such as those that marred New Orleans' New Years festivities and German Christmas markets. LT Van Note stated that VBPD performs coordinated table-top and field exercises to attempt to prevent and respond to such incidents. VBPD also shares data with state and federal law enforcement agencies all of whom regularly sweep social media for threatening postings. Regrettably, if a malcontent has mayhem on their mind and has not shared such intent, there is little that can be done to completely prevent such tragedies. In that regard, people need to remain aware of their surroundings (situational awareness). This includes not being encumbered by focusing on cell phones at the expense of your own safety.
